### Pastor Mony Mok and wife Kunnary



Pastor Mony Mok became orphaned at the age of 17 with the invasion of Phnom Penh by the Khmer Rouge. At a refugee camp in Thailand, he received the Lord Jesus Christ and was called into ministry. He graduated from the University of Washington and Fuller Seminary. He Pastors Cambodia Harvest Church in Long Beach, Ca. and has started 250 Churches in Cambodia.

Pastor Mony met Fran in 1997 in Seattle. He invited her to speak in his Church in California and in Cambodia. While in Cambodia, Pastor Mony shared his heart about an orphanage. During a thunderstorm that evening, God woke Fran from her sleep and told her that He



wanted her to be the one to start the orphanage. She now has 20 orphans in "River of Life Orphanage". Fran provides housing, schooling, and all the needs of the children.

## Our Mission

Fran ministers by the Holy Spirit around the world. Her outreach goals are:

- ◆ To train men and women to evangelize and minister in their countries through leadership conferences and Bible distribution.
- ◆ To obtain sponsors to help meet the needs of children who have lost their parents through AIDS, malaria or starvation, and protect them from slave traders.
- ◆ To reach out to the poor spiritually, as led by the Holy Spirit, through travels to remote villages ministering in Churches, homes, and fields, and financially through rice distribution to the starving.

## Uganda

Moses and Martha Mutyaba are pastors in Entebbe, Uganda. Their ministry "Home of Comfort Orphanage" in Namulanda, cares for 60 of the "Lost Children of Uganda".

Parents, killed by rebel soldiers, left children forced to join the rebel army or become sex slaves. Only a few managed to escape, and are currently under the care of the Mutyabas.



Through monetary gifts from Free Lance Ministries, the Mutyabas today provide a spiritual foundation, food, medical, dental, clothing and beds for the orphanage.

In 2008, a school, kindergarden through primary 3, has been opened for the orphans and village children. The older children from Grade 4 and up must pay school fees and purchase uniforms in order to attend public schools.

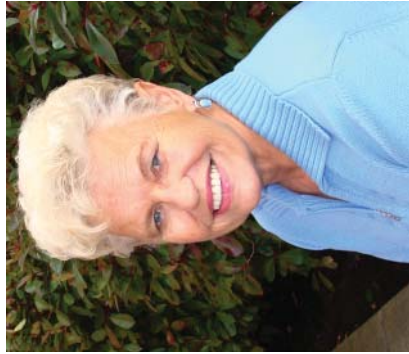

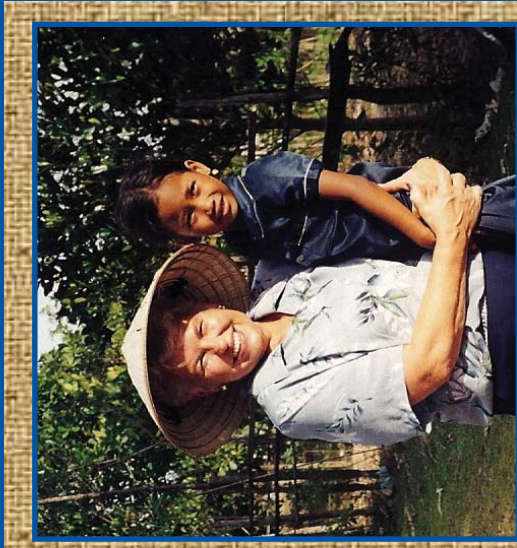
